Sale Guidelines:

1. CONSIGNMENT INFORMATION & FEE MUST BE SUBMITTED TO NCAA BY THE DEADLINE OF **September 12, 2024**. Late consignments will NOT be accepted.

 - b. Find printable consignment form on ncangus.org
2. Sale will be conducted under the standard terms and conditions of the American Angus Association and CCI.live.
3. Sale fees
 - a. NCAA Consignor Entry fee - \$25/consignment (non-refundable) or 6.5% of selling price, whichever is greater.
 - b. Consignors must be members of the NC Angus Association. If not a current paid member, dues are \$50 and must be submitted before consignments will be accepted. Payment may be sent to NCAA office or purchased online at <https://nc-angus-association.square.site/>
4. Sellers must communicate with the buyer of their lot/lots regarding shipping arrangements at the conclusion of the sale.
 - a. It will be the buyer's responsibility to pay for shipping of their purchase. We ask that sellers help with shipping arrangements as needed.
 - b. NC Angus Association will confirm with the seller once payment has been received from the buyer. (It is recommended that sellers do not ship items until payment is received.)
 - c. NC Angus Association requests sellers confirm shipment of semen/embryos to assist NCAA in keeping proper records regarding the sale.
5. If the seller does NOT ship or provide semen/embryos to the buyer within the agreed upon time frame (time frame determined between seller and buyer), the seller will be required to pay NCAA for the full selling price of the lot/lots so a refund can be made to the buyer who received no product.

Embryos

- All donors must have DNA on file to prove parentage for embryo consignments. If the donor is not owned by the consignor, it is still the consignor's responsibility to ensure DNA is on file with the AAA.
- It is recommended that consignors guarantee a certain number of embryos from their sale lot but is not required. For more information, contact a member of the NCAA Marketing Committee.

Semen

- According to the AAA suggested sale terms, unless otherwise agreed by the buyer and the seller, with respect to the sale of semen the seller makes no guarantees with respect to the performance or characteristics of such semen and the buyer is purchasing such semen "as is." However, if a seller is found to be knowingly offering defective semen, he or she may be barred from selling in future NCAA sales.
- There will be a 5 unit minimum per semen lot.
